Principals Message

September in Secondary Schools starts with a predictable flurry of activity, organization, correcting timetable conflicts and attending to class change requests by students. As staff start to wind down these essential organizational tasks, our collective efforts shift to our school development plan goals.

One of the ways we attend to our school development plan goals is through our weekly Professional Learning Communities (PLC). Every Monday at 2pm, our teaching staff devotes time to focus on continuous instructional improvement through planned and intentional responses to evidence of achievement and data about the learning conditions that support student success.

The PLC focus at NDSS year is on tasks that teachers and educational assistants can implement with individual students or entire classrooms. The tasks will be based on universal teaching practices that have been proven as highly effective in supporting and improving the academic and social-emotional needs of secondary students.

As the Principal, I lead PLC work with our Vice-Principals, Mr. Shahi and Mr. Epp, and our Learning Leaders, Ms. Barnum, Mr. Crnkovic, Ms. Funk, Mr. Jansen, Ms. Taylor, Mrs. Smith, and Ms. McKibbon-Bell. This group of 10 are the Leaders of Learning at NDSS and collectively support all teachers and educational assistants during our weekly PLC's. We are thrilled that NDSS has received district support for this PLC work. Two NLPS Learning Coordinators, Ms. Gvojich and Ms. Lavoie, have been assigned to NDSS and will be joining us at our regular planning meetings to provide resources to support the creation of differentiated tasks for our teaching staff to implement with students.

For the month of September, we are in the planning phase of the PLC process as a large group and will begin sharing tasks with teachers in mid-October. Updates and examples of the implementation of PLC work in all courses will be provided in each term as part of this publication. We hope that you will look forward reading the PLC updates in my newsletter message and, perhaps more importantly, that you will see evidence of how this work supports your child's learning at NDSS.

Parking Concerns

- Some students parking in Serauxman lot have been seen "drifting" n the west side lot, resulting in sprayed gravel onto vehicles and equipment. Driving in a reckless manner may lead to police fines and/or loss of their student parking pass.
- Some of our parents who are dropping off or picking up their teens have been pulling into the district parking lot near our music room portable off Wakesiah. This lot is reserved for district staff and parents are kindly asked not to enter that lot.
- NDSS buses drop off & pick up using the back lane between the field and main school building. To ensure student safety, vehicles are not permitted in the laneway from 8:15-8:30am M-F, 1:30-2:00pm Mon/Fri and 2:30-3:10pm Tues/Wed/Thur.
- Flashing red lights on the back of a school bus mean that drivers in vehicles behind them need to stop their car and wait. It is illegal to drive around a school bus when their red lights are flashing as students can dart out unexpectedly.
