GRADUATION UPDATE

- NLPS Secondary Principals have all agreed to pause planning and discussion pertaining to June 2022 grad until mid-April.
- This is to wait and see if scheduled BC Ministry of Health updates will include information that may guide our available options. Families of grade 12's can anticipate receiving some concrete information by end the of April at the very latest.
- What know is that NDSS graduation celebrations (*format, location, and size TBD*) will occur between June 27-29th. We may have several sm. convocations here at the school or a larger, whole group, processional style ceremony off site. Stay tuned.
- In the meantime, our grad committee would like to purchase NDSS swag gifts for our graduates as is our tradition regardless of format. Funds for these gifts are part of grad fees. We encourage you to pay these fees now as only 50% have to date.

- NDSS has not yet received our shipment of rapid tests for students from the Ministry. We will let you know when we do.
