#### **UPCOMING REPORT CARDS**

- Teachers will soon be writing second semester interim report card comments and inputting marks in MyEd (end of term 3).
- MyEd access for parents/students to view marks/transcripts will be suspended from Tues,. April 26th to Wed May 3, 2022.
- Electronic report cards will be released in MyEd to parents/students on Wednesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> between 2:00-4:00pm.
- Hard copies of reports cards are not sent home, so please verify that your account is accessible prior to May 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- If a teacher has insufficient data to assess progress for a gr.8/9 student, then the <u>proficiency scale</u> space may be blank and parent receive an 'incomplete (i) report' via email. Gr. 10-12's in similar situations receive a mark and an emailed "i" report.

### PARENT SURVEY ACCESS

- Several parents contacted us to share that they were having difficulty accessing the learning survey that we are encouraging

- The survey is open until Fri, April 29th, and takes approximately 30 min. Responses are voluntary, anonymous, and your child will not be identified because of your participation. Personal/identifying information is deleted before results are stored.
