## **Indigenous-Focused Graduation Requirement**

As you may be aware, the Ministry of Education has mandated that all grade 12 students must complete at least 4 credits in Indigenous focused coursework to graduate. To ensure that NDSS students meet this requirement, we will be offering English First Peoples 12 to all learners signed up for English 12 in semester two this year. The reason for this change is that we have numerous students in grade 11 who have signed up for English 12 who are accelerating their programs, finishing early, attending CTC programs, taking dual credit, and a host of other personal and educational reasons. Additionally, this decision aligns with the school, district, and provincial goals and commitment to Truth and Reconciliation. Next year, the district has made the decision that all grade 12 students will be taking English First Peoples 12 to ensure that this requirement is met.

## Course selection is coming up soon!

Course selection will begin next week for our grade 9-11 students. If this proves difficult, students always have access to computers in the NDSS library. Grade 9-11 students will be watching a video in their A block class next week to help outline this process. Students will need access to their MyEd account in order to complete course selection. Grade 8 students will be completing their course selection with counsellors between February 10<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>.
