## PAC OPPORTUNITIES

Hello NDSS parents and guardians! I'd like to encourage you to join us for our monthly PAC meetings. If you are new to NDSS or are still feeling burnt out from elementary school PAC involvement, please know that it is different in high school! We do not fundraise, and our meetings typically run for no more than an hour. The highlight of the meeting is hearing the report from our principal which keeps us informed of the day-to-day operations of the school.
