



Instructions for Selecting Your Courses in My Ed BC

1. Enter your login ID and password. Your Login ID is always s68. and your student number (ie. s68.123456). If you have forgotten your password, click on the "I forgot password" button. A temporary password will be sent to your learn 68 email.

Welcome to NDSS Course Selection for Students Entering Grade 11!

GRADE 11 PROGRAM

All Grade 11 **English Stream** students must take the following as part of the Graduation Program:

- One (1) English Language Arts 11 course - 4 credits
- One (1) Mathematics 11 course - 4 credits
- One (1) Science 11 course - 4 credits
- One (1) Social Studies 11 or 12 course - 4 credits

All Grade 11 **French Immersion Stream** students must take the following as part of the Graduation Program:

- One (1) English Language Arts 11 course - 4 credits
- One (1) French Immersion 11 course - 4 credits
- One (1) Math 11 course (see immersion requirements below) - 4 credits
- One (1) Science 11 course - 4 credits
- One (1) Social Studies 11 or 12 course (see immersion requirements below) - 4 credits

Note - In order to graduate with a Double Dogwood students must take two of the following six options in French as apart of the grade requirements









5. Your selected courses will now appear in the Primary Requests section.


