ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Congratulations to two of our Francophone students who won a bursary!

They received \$1,000 for their project proposal over the weekend during a retreat with the *Conseil jeunesse francophone de la Colombie-Britannique*. They will use the money to put their project into action for the Francophone students NDSS.

Their proposal focussed on organizing weekend tours to Vancouver so that Francophone students can have guided tours of French programs at UBC and SFU, a chance to connect to graduates of the CSF Francophone program and of French programs at the universities, as well as fun activities and social time to connect as Francophone students.

eConsent:

October 15, 2023 was the deadline to receive tech/cloud consent from parents/caregivers. Starting October 20, 2023, any student without a tech/cloud consent response *recorded into the eConsent app* will have their access to cloud apps through their learn68 account suspended until a <u>YES</u> response has been entered.

In eConsent, no response = no consent

The eCloud form can be resent *if you have not responded*, please remember to check your JUNK MAIL folder.

Note: Students use their learn68 accounts to access educational apps in the 'cloud' such as Google Classroom, MS 365/Teams, Canvas and more.

NDSS currently has a response rate of 75%, which means that as of October 20th, 25% of our students will lose access to learn68 and cloud apps. Please ensure that you complete these to avoid disruption in service!
